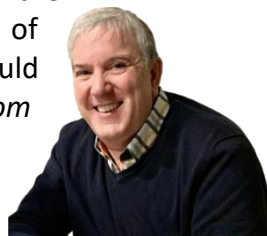
A year later, the book was translated into Spanish and printed in Spain.

Launched in Spain and Latin America

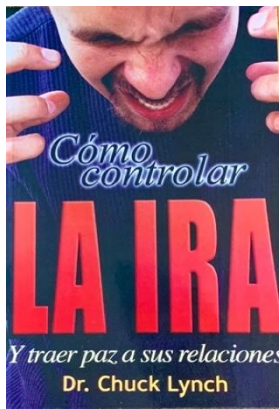
Dr. Marcos Zapata, the president of the National Evangelical Association of Spain, asked us last year if we would write a book on *How to Heal from Adultery*.

Translating our book, *God's Peace in Your Home*, into Portuguese was a two-year project. Pastor Paulo and Ana Maria just announced that the book was published and launched at the Assemblies of God Pastors National Convention in Portugal. We are humbled and grateful for the hard work that made this new resource available in Portuguese.





Over the past 20 years, the Spanish edition of *God's Peace in Your Home (Como Controlar La Ira)* has been printed in Spain, Mexico and Venezuela and distributed throughout Latin America. All proceeds from these books remain in their respective countries to further biblical counseling training there.

Chris Goes to Prison

The Lord opened a door for Pastor Chris Chantres, our Latin American coordinator, to minister at a small prison in Puebla, Mexico. A group of 20 out of 100 men meet every other Tuesday for a couple of hours.



Chris has been discipling them from the Spanish Biblical Counseling Manual. The men were shocked when they heard a positive side of anger to reveal needs and then how to forgive from the heart. Many were in tears as they processed personal pain

and how to live with the memories. The security guards who heard the teaching said they noticed positive changes in the prisoners. Soon there will be a baptism in the prison and some of their families will get to attend. Celebrate with us. God is at work even behind bars!

Cancer Challenge Returns

Chuck just received the biopsy report on the small lump on his lower leg. It is pleomorphic sarcoma cancer. The next step is to see an orthopedic oncologist at KU Med Center. We are just residents in God's temple (the body) and are trusting Him for whatever the future holds. So far, we don't need to change any of our international training schedule.
